Proposed Change: Reduce primary care medical and nutrition services by approximately 20,000 visits annually. Extended hours and Saturday hours will be discontinued at each facility. The anticipated result of reduced availability of appointments is decreased access to primary care and increased wait times for appointments.

Staff Reductions: A total of forty (40) positions are proposed to be defunded. They are:

Patients/Clients Affected:

The Family Care Centers serve 65,000 patients providing 175,000 visits annually to the residents of Riverside County. The reduction of staff/ services will result in 20,000 fewer available appointments for primary care and nutrition services. Approximately 25,000 (40%) of the total clients served are medically indigent.

Expected Savings:

The proposed reductions will reduce expenditures by \$3,482,807.00. The reductions will result in the loss of revenue in the amount of \$1,428,163.00, and will yield a cost reduction of \$2,054,644.00.
