COMMUNITY ACTION COMMISSION SEEKS DESERT APPLICANTS

Community Action Partnership of Riverside County is seeking applicants to serve on the Community Action Commission. The Community Action Commission is a tripartite body, comprised of three sectors: low-income, private and public. The low-income sector members are selected by a vote of the public at an upcoming meeting.

- Commissioners are volunteers who are dedicated to the mission of community action and are willing to participate on committee assignments and Commission activities.
- Applicants must reside in the Fourth Supervisorial District, which includes Blythe, Cathedral City, Coachella, Desert Hot Springs, Indian Wells, Indio, La Quinta, Palm Desert, Palm Springs and Rancho Mirage.
- Applicants need not themselves be low-income; however, preference in selection shall be given to low-income individuals.
- Applicants must be at least 18.
- Applicants cannot be a paid staff member of Community Action Partnership, or a relative of the Community Action staff, Commission or the County Board of Supervisors.
- Applicants must complete and return an application to the Community Action Partnership Riverside office by the Dec. 20, 2016 deadline.
- The Commissioners will be elected at a Community Forum to be held at 9 a.m., on Thursday, Dec. 22, 2016 at the Desert Hot Springs Family Resource Center, located at 14201 Palm Drive, in Desert Hot Springs.
