Public Health officials announce third Safe Talk suicide awareness and prevention training in Desert Hot Springs

(Desert Hot Springs, CA) In response to the overwhelming public interest, Riverside County health officials will host a third Safe Talk suicide awareness and prevention training Sept. 27 in Desert Hot Springs.

Participants will learn the warning signs and risk factors for someone who may be considering suicide, along with the resources that are available to all residents. The interactive presentation will include group discussions, role-playing and the opportunity to engage trainers with questions. The training is a collaboration between Riverside University Health System Public Health and Behavioral Health.

The training is free and open to the public, but attendees are asked to pre-register.
