## Banning-based doctor named interim health officer for Riverside County

A physician who has worked for the Department of Public Health for about five years has been named interim health officer for Riverside County.

Cameron Kaiser was named to the post Tuesday by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.

Kaiser, 35, has served as a primary care physician at the department's Banning Family Care Center since September 2006 and served as a medical consultant to the county for tuberculosis control during that same period. He received his medical degree at the Loma Linda University in 2003 and bachelor of science degree in general linguistics from the University of California, San Diego, in 1997.

The county health officer is appointed by the Board of Supervisors to enforce County ordinances and state and federal statutes pertaining to public health and sanitary matters within the unincorporated areas of the county and within all cities in Riverside County.

Kaiser replaces Dr. Eric Frykman, who resigned last week as public health officer and director of the county Community Health Agency. Kaiser assumes the interim duties of health officer. Health agency officials, in conjunction with the county Executive Office, will continue to administer the agency during the interim period.
